WHY 1:1 FOR LMS AND ADDITIONAL DEVICES AT THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS?

The 1:1 initiative at the high school has been a wonderful success for our students. That success was discussed by the C3 Committee, made up of Board members, administrators, teachers, and parents. After doing research and discussing the cost, the group presented a proposal to extend the 1:1 model at LMS, along with supplying about 50 additional devices to each elementary school. This was presented to the Board and Budget Committee as a warrant article for 250,000 to bring to the voters.
